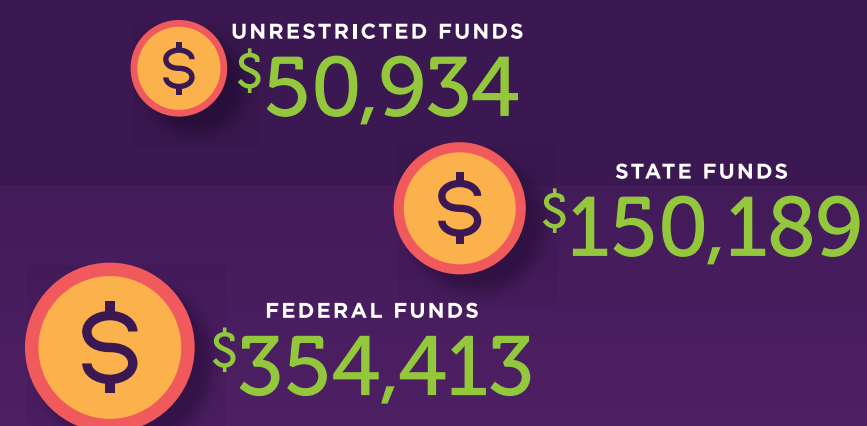
Legal Services Breakdown
